CONSTRUCTION READY

Construction Ready is a short-term, boot camp style program that helps employers find screened, trained, entry level talent TODAY. Graduates of the program are drug-free, trained, credentialed and motivated to work. In the two years since the launch of Construction Ready, CEFGA has trained and placed over 400 metro Atlanta residents into full-time positions, with a 90-day retention rate of greater than 80 percent. While Construction Ready is primarily funded through private foundation and government support, additional industry support is needed to amplify the impact and expansion of this program.



The K12 Pipeline is designed to build a sustainable workforce for your company, while helping Georgia students build a rewarding career in the construction industry. The Pipeline includes a statewide network of high school construction programs that teach entry-level skills and provide nationally-recognized NCCER credentials to over 7,000 students each year. The Pipeline also includes one of the nation's largest exploration events for students, the CareerExpo. As an employer, this two-day event, that attracts more than 7,000 attendees each year, is an opportunity for you to meet your future workforce and brand the construction industry and your company as a great place to work.
